**Domestic Abuse and Sexual Assault Crisis Center of Warren County
Building Fire**

WASHINGTON, NJ – October 3, 2021 – It is with a heavy heart that we inform all of our friends and supporters that there was a fire in one of our buildings this weekend. All clients and staff in the building were evacuated and are safe. There was significant damage to portions of the building, and it is unusable at the present time.

All staff working in the building and all families who are being served have been relocated to other sites. It is unclear at this time how long it will take to repair the damage and reoccupy the building. Since this just happened, we are still working to assess the damage, and will update our community as we have more information. The important thing is that all the families and staff are safe. We are continuing to offer services and remain available to those impacted by interpersonal violence in Warren County.

How you can help: We are in need of Visa/Mastercard gift cards for our clients, to help them purchase food and replace lost belongings. If you are able to provide them in amounts of \$25, it would be very helpful. As our future needs become clear, we will be asking you for your support.
