All proceeds from this fundraiser and community awareness event will benefit DASACC, allowing our staff to continue reaching and serving survivors of interpersonal violence in Warren County and surrounding areas. *We hope that you will consider supporting our event by becoming a sponsor and/or donating an item or basket to raffle.* We are expecting over 100 guests, and all donations are tax deductible (EIN: 22-2357790). The event also includes a beefsteak dinner, consisting of butter-dipped beef tenderloin, sliced thin and served on fresh bread, accompanied by potato fries and salad. The competitive spirit of the event extends to dinner, where attendees have been known to stack leftover bread slices as tallies and monuments of beefsteaks consumed. We will also offer additional options upon request for those with dietary restrictions.

- Services to over **1,723** women, men and children affected by domestic and/or sexual violence.
- Over 8,935 individual and group counseling sessions.
- Over 15,016 instances of case management.
- Crisis assistance to over **1,400** hotline calls.
